



Membership Policy

- Members must be local in geographic proximity, practice sustainable strategies, and participate in fair and direct trade.
- Members pay an annual \$100 investment into the Co-op, which is then held in specific farm accounts. This money will always belong to the farm and is not a fee.
- Members are prioritized on our Local Orbit online marketplace.
- Farms are allowed one 'trial period' to decide if they wish to join LINC which ends automatically once the designated sales threshold of \$500 is reached. At this time, the \$100 will be due regardless of the decision to join or not.
- In the event that LINC is unable to secure specific items from within the Co-op membership, LINC's sales team will seek other sustainable options outside of the Co-op.

Local Guidelines

- LINC's territory is bounded within the Inland NW territory of the Cascade Mountains to the West, the Rocky Mountains to the East, the Blue Mountains and Wallowa Foothills to the South and SE, and Canada to the North.
- Members must be located within a 3 hour driving perimeter from LINC Foods headquarters in Spokane, WA.
